#### REPORT OF THE POLICE CHIEF

The Belmont Police Department went through many changes this year. In February the Town appointed its first police chief that had not come from within the ranks of the department. Richard J. McLaughlin was appointed Police Chief, by the Board of Selectmen on February 26, 2007. Acting Chief Richard J Lane returned to his former position as Assistant Chief.

The year started out with 46 sworn Officers and one Officer in the academy. In early spring Sgt. Ken Hamilton retired with over thirty years of service to the Town and in November Lieutenant Edward Reilly and Lieutenant William Kenney also retired both with over thirty years of service.

With the retirements and reorganization by the new Chief, the Board of Selectmen appointed Mark Hurley, Kevin Shea, and Kim Hurley to the rank of Sergeant, Brendon O'Leary and Jamie MacIsaac to the rank of Lieutenant and Peter Hoerr to the rank of Captain.

Besides personnel changes the Department worked with an appointed committee on a Feasibility Study of the aging Belmont Police Department building. The committee will be presenting its final report in 2008.

The Department continues to update its equipment. The first phase of purchasing new radios for the Officers was implemented this year with the completion to take place in 2008. Also a state of the art fingerprint machine was purchased and installed. All Officers were trained in the new procedures and this will give the Department instant access to fingerprint records.

As always our first priority is public safety. The Department will continue to be proactive in serving the public and we will continue to do a better job with a community policing philosophy.
