Recent Activity Update

Chief's Message

BPD was awarded a grant in collaboration with the Advocates and the Department of Mental Health. The grant will provide us with a Social Worker/Co-Responder to work and respond alongside our sworn officers. A Co-Responder is currently working with us two days a week until a full-time social worker is selected.

Traffic Department

A BPD Officer will be starting a 3 month traffic assignment targeting intersections with the most amounts of crashes over the previous 2 years. Officers will be assigned to the intersection twice a day to help educate drivers.

Detective Bureau

We have seen an increase in identity fraud cases. It is always a good idea to periodically check your credit report. This will insure no one has opened up any fraudulent accounts with your information. Many people are utilizing credit monitoring services which help provide an extra layer of protection to your personal information. Please report any fraud to us as soon as possible.

Community Services

Crimes targeting Belmont Senior Citizens are on the rise. The two most common ones we see:

- 1.) A phone call or a notification on your computer stating there is a security breach/virus on your computer and the company can fix the problem. Immediately hang up or turn off your computer. Criminals are attempting to gain access to your computer and/or get exorbitant amounts of money for "fixing" your computer.

- 2.) Texts/emails from banks or companies such as Amazon. Texts will state there is an issue with your account send you a link to log into your account. The link looks like your bank or Amazon but is not. Do not log in!
